HOW IT WORKS: Carbon emissions associated with the delivery and preservation of food is being watched more closely than ever. Green Chef has taken a proactive approach to ensure that every single meal kit has been balanced with carbon offsets from terrapass. All aspects have been accounted for in this offset program - from the energy consumed to keep the food refrigerated to the exact number of miles that the kits travel to arrive on the customers table.

GREEN CHEF DOES MORE THAN OFFSET MEAL KITS: All emissions from corporate travel are tracked and offset with the help of terrapass. Everything from the flight level data, aircraft type, route and fuel consumption is calculated to receive an accurate report.

- ✓ More than 1,842 metric tons of carbon have been offset thus far, which is equivalent to saving 207,269 gallons of gasoline or 4,265 barrels of oil. ¹
